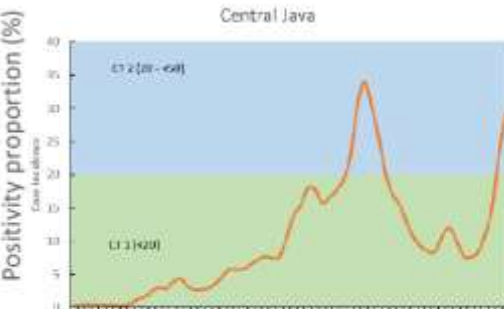
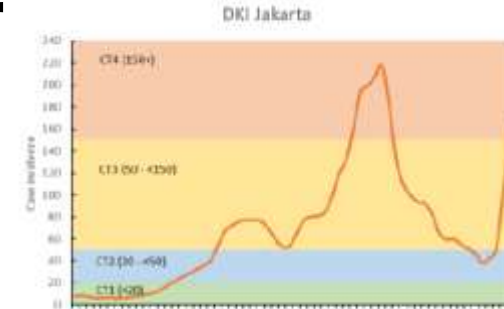

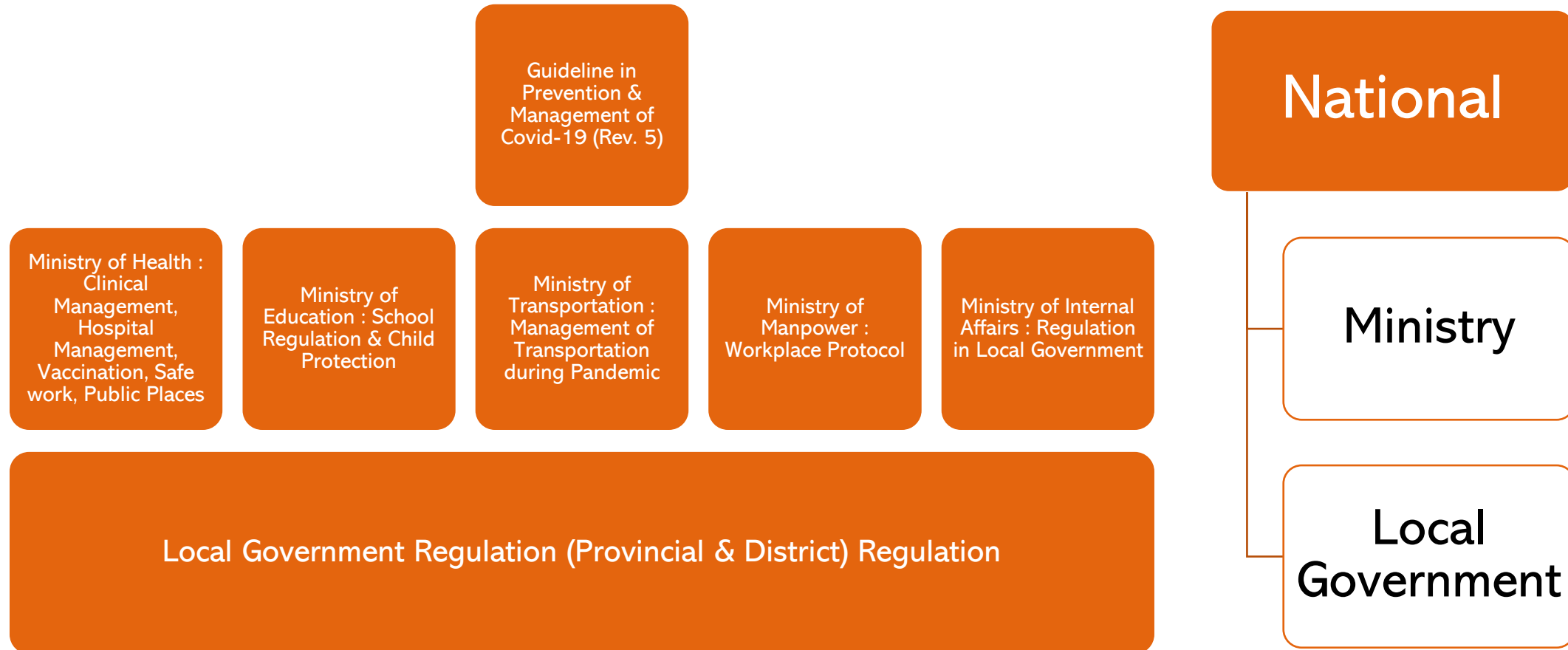

# Protocols Covid-19 Indonesia

# Implementation of Protocol : Companies (7 Provinces, 74 Companies)

---

- More than 90 % large scale industry have internal regulation related to covid-19 and already announced to their employee, but less than 50 % of SME did this
- More than 80 % large scale industry have risk assessment of workers related to covid-19 but less than 20 % SME did this
- Factors related with incidence of cases at company :
  - Facilitating safe transportation for workers
  - Implement WFH when necessary
  - Testing & Tracing activities done by company

# Implementation of Protocol : Upstream Oil & Gas Companies (20 companies & 4895 respondents)

---

- More than 95 % companies did temperature screening and more than 80 % did questionnaire based screening upon entry
- About 40 % respondents didn't have regulation related to eating together & 52 % respondents didn't provided their lunch by company
- About 27 % still underwent offline meeting
- More than 10 % had psychosocial complaints and exhausted due to prolonged rotation

# Implementation of Protocol : Upstream Oil & Gas Companies (20 companies & 4895 respondents)

---

- About 15 % didn't frequently use mask
- More than 90 % complaints about lack of hand washing facilities
- Physical distancing can be implemented by 67,6 % at workplace
- Frequent hand washing practice implemented by 84,3 %
- About 50,5 % respondents could avoid crowds



## Implementation of Protocol : Public Places (7 provinces, 150 places : Hotel, restaurants, mall, religious, etc)

---

- More than 50 % already have a dedicated team, job task, and training related with covid-19 protocols at public places
- About 13,3 % couldn't implement physical distancing
- There were 38 % didn't have capacity limitation for guests and workers
- Hand washing facility already available in more than 96 % public places but only 50 % implement hand washing practice
- More than 97 % already have regulation in wearing mask and implemented by 63,3 % of guests and workers

## Implementation of Protocol : Public Places (7 provinces, 150 places : Hotel, restaurants, mall, religious, etc)

---

- Public places implemented good protocol : hotel & mall
- Public places implemented poor protocol : traditional market
- Factors related with protocol implementation :
  - Supervision / guard
  - Availability of facilities (handwashing)

# Conclusion

---

- GoI already facilitate with complete regulation of covid-19 protocol at levels for companies and public places
- Implementation of protocols are challenging in Indonesia
  - SME
  - Traditional market
  - Basic protocol
- Factors related to protocol implementation are :
  - Availability of facilities
  - Supervision
  - Implementation of specific preventive action
